

## Calculation of Grades, GPVs, and GPAs - Batch 2018/19

1. Overview of the calculations:

- i. First, the total marks (%) obtained for each course (in-course assessments + end-semester exam) will be converted to a Grade Point Value (GPV) for each course
- ii. Secondly, an end-semester Grade Point Average will be calculated based on the GPVs obtained for each course (semester-GPA =  $\sum c_i g_i / \sum c_i$ , where  $c_i$  and  $g_i$  are the number of credits and the GPV for the  $i$ th course unit, respectively)
- iii. At the end of the 10 semesters, a cumulative-GPA will be calculated based on the semester-GPAs from all 10 semesters.
- iv. Finally, a class will be awarded based on the cumulative-GPA

2. Letter Grades and GPVs for a particular course will be calculated as per the table below.

In case of repeat examinations;

- i. Even if the total marks obtained for a particular course are >50%, the highest grade that will be awarded for the course will be a 'C'. Therefore, the highest GPV that will be awarded for the course in case of a repeat examination is 2.0.
- ii. The grade from the successful attempt will be listed on the transcript indicating number of the attempt.
- iii. The GPA will be calculated based on the GPV of the successful retake (GPV = 2.0) of the same course

3. Awarding of classes after successful completion of the 10 semesters will be based on the following table
